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## Nominee For Garden Patio Villas Board Position Rules

- A Nominee must be a Member in good standing with *Garden Patio Villas*. (Not delinquent in the payment of any fee, fine, or other monetary obligation to the Association.)
- A Nominee must submit, in writing, their desire to be on the Board of Directors by submitting a "Board of Directors Nominee Application."
- An interview will be scheduled with all Nominees to go over requirements and submit to a background check.
- Nominees must sign a "Code of Conduct" form to adhere and follow our Governing Documents, Rules & Regulations and the Florida Statutes 720.
- A "Meet and Greet" will be scheduled to get to know all the Candidates running for the Board of Directors for all the Members of the Association.
- 6. Nominees are not allowed to copy ballots.
- 7. Nominees are not allowed to fill out ballots for other Members.
- 8. Nominees are not allowed to post on our Association bulletin boards.
- 9. Nominees may encourage individual Members to vote for them.
- 10. Nominees are encouraged to get "Board Certified" early to learn the basics of how a Florida Homeowners Association operates. (Florida Statutes 720 requires certification from all Board of Directors within the first 90 days.)

## Rules must be adhered to by all Nominees. Failure to comply, may result in the automatic withdrawal of a Nominee from the ballot for Board of Directors.
